
From one year to the next

"It's as if I'm someone else or as if I'm trying to be someone else".







Draw whatever you want

This book was created based on research carried out for the project CLAN, using interviews with families and children who share their homes with cats, dogs and other animal species.






This book likes to ask questions. This book prefers a world full of questions than a world with definitive answers.




An invasive species

When Ana was a child, she would play on the beach. Gradually, she noticed a new species becoming more common along the shore: plastic.


