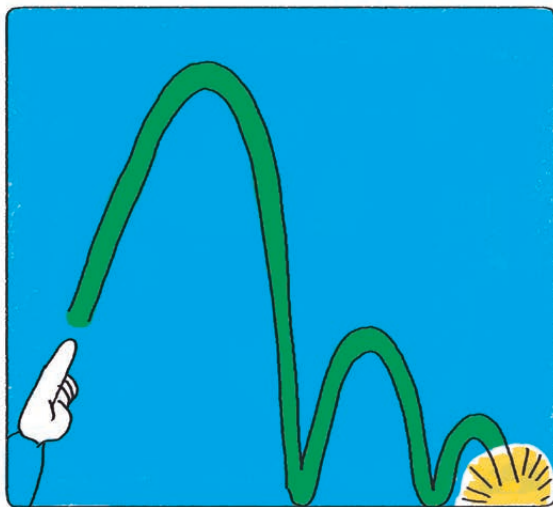
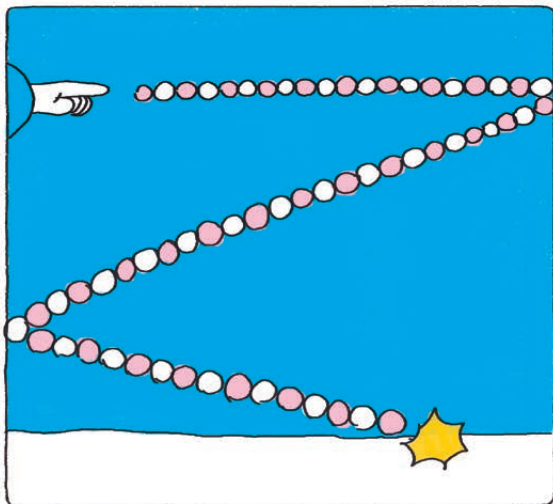

We've always tried to set Planeta Tangerina apart from other projects for children by publishing books with a limited number of pirates, princesses, magic wands, teddy bears and... yes, cats and dogs too (we've got nothing against these characters or books, it's just that there are already so many!). At a certain point, however, a publisher gains momentum and there's no point trying to halt it, especially when that impulse is the result of an unbridled and joyful movement. And that's why, this year, we've ended up with one book that woofs (*Bow wow!*) after another which meowed (*Meow!*) and two books about cats from far-off continents (*European shorthair*) and (*Mr Magic Cat*).

Beyond these books, which followed, one on the tail of another via a series of coincidences, we've also got: a book which delves deep into the scientific world in order to explain what everything is made of (*The smallest parts*), a book which reflects on the state of the world in terms of consumption and waste (*The point we're at*), another which plays with the world of language (*A rose, for example*), and two books which caught our eye during the latest edition of the Serpa Award: the winning entry, *In the tent*, and Special Mention, *All together*, each introducing new authors into our catalogue.

And so it is that we, and you readers too, have more than enough reasons to purr and wag our tails – but barking loudly and getting our claws out continue to be very important too, and we haven't forgotten that.

So please, join us in purring, barking and getting your claws out too! We love having you by our side.

The point we're at

Maybe this is a sad book — and people, particularly when thinking about books for children, almost always prefer happy books, hopeful books.

We agree. Hope is the most important thing in the world. But in order not to lose it for once and for all, we must see the world as it is right now. So as to change it, to fix it, to make a plan!

Conclusion: this is only a sad book if everything remains the same. If no one bats an eyelid, if no one takes a stand, if no one decides to change.

Isabel Minhós Martins and Bernardo P. Carvalho have gone and done it again. In their latest picturebook, they challenge us — with a series of provocations and a sharp sense of humour — to reflect on the state of the world.

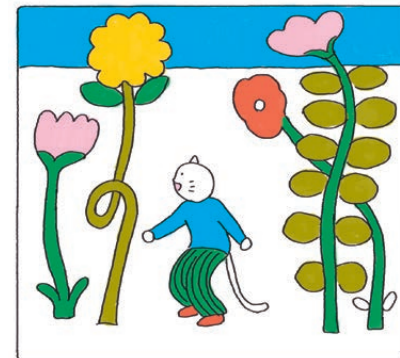
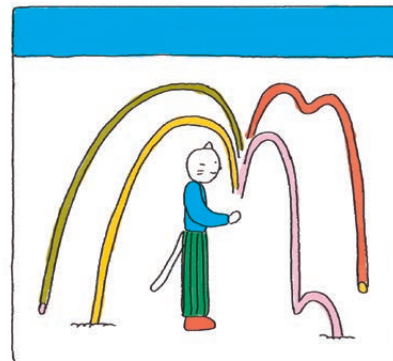
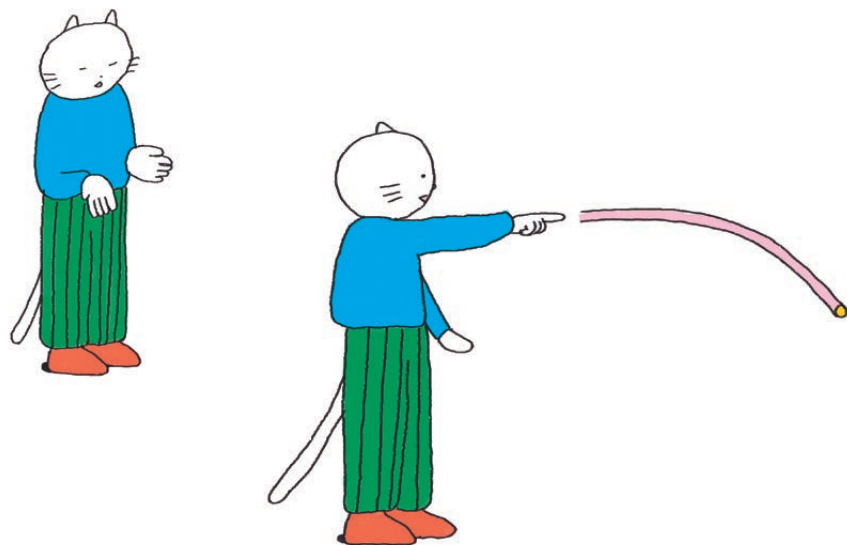

Bow wow!

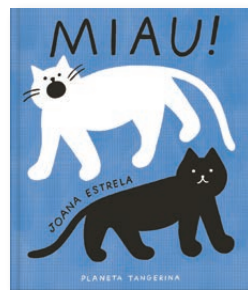
Two “silent” cartoons which, despite being wordless, meow and bark aplenty!
